GUIDELINES FOR ANNUAL RECOGNITION AWARDS

Qualifications: A nominee must be a graduate, former student, or legacy of Henderson Institute; or a former teacher at Henderson Institute.

Procedures

- The Committee will review how the individual relates to other nominees, outstanding contributions made to the community; chosen profession, and/or career. These are more important than a list of offices held, or honors received.
- 2. Nominations must include a narrative typed or clearly handwritten, double-spaced, but not more than five (5) pages. It should be well organized and neat. It may include: (a) activities that inspired you to nominate the individual; (b) comments about the nominee from employers, peers, coworkers, family and/or a community person. These should be included in the five (5) pages.
- 3. Nominations should be submitted by regular mail, postmarked no later than <u>July 25, 2022</u> to <u>Ola Thorpe-Cooper</u>. The nominee will be notified in writing of his/her nomination, unless specifically requested not to do so by the person making the nomination.
- Awards will be presented at the Annual Banquet. A nominee may be submitted more than once for consideration. Yes, a person may nominate him/herself.
- 5. Each recipient, or his/her designee, is expected to attend the Banquet at his/her own expense.

Award Categories

Please review each category description carefully before making a nomination.

- 1. **Humanitarian**: A person who has made outstanding contributions to the welfare of humanity.
- 2. **Hall of Fame**: A person having excelled in athletics, education, medicine, business, government, military, etc.

- 3. **Community Leader:** Someone who recognizes a need in the community and takes the necessary steps to meet those needs. (i.e. mentoring "at risk" kids, organizing help for the needy; organizing crime prevention programs, etc.)
- 4. **Service**: Someone who has given outstanding service and support to the success of our Association and/or Annual Reunions.
