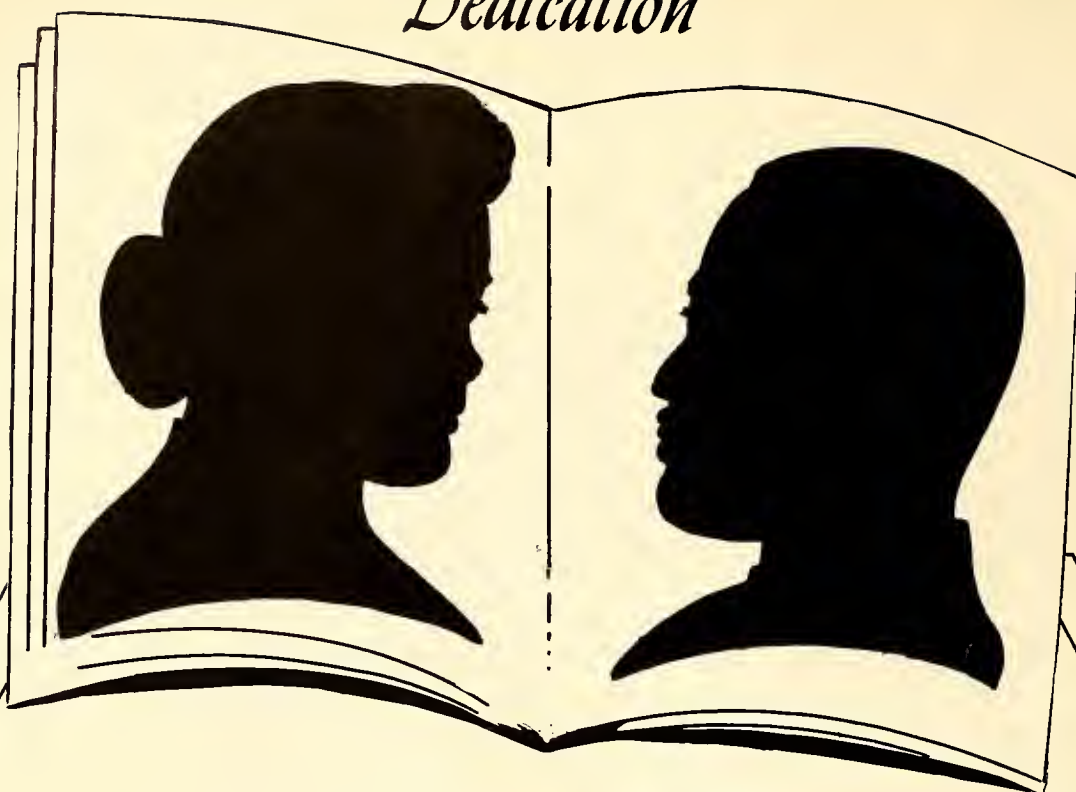

In this yearbook, we have recorded the deeds that will serve as a reminder of our duties to our fellowmen, parents, instructors and our dear Alma Mater, H. I.

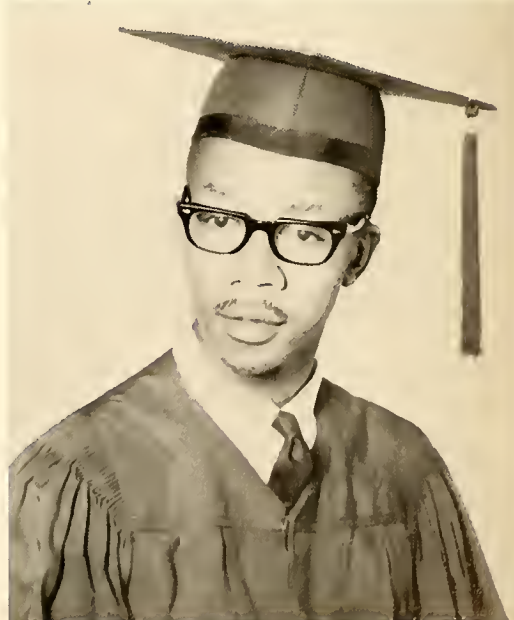

Class History

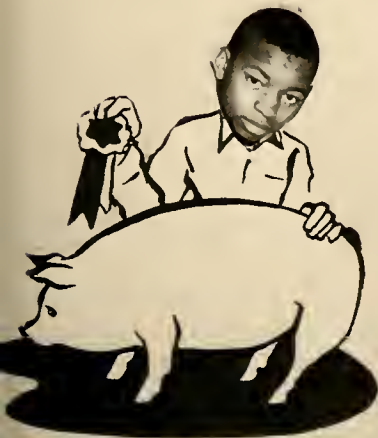
